# World Mission Sunday – October 22<sup>nd</sup>

At the initiative of Pope Pius XI in 1926, the second last Sunday during October became known as World Mission Sunday. Catholics thoughout the world are invited to pray for and give to the missions. The collection this Sunday is organized by the Pontifical Missions Society. The funds collected assist some 1,250 mission dioceses under the responsibility of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples. As agreed by the Holy See and the Bishops of Canada, a portion of the Canadian contributions to this collection will continue to be used until 202 to assist six dioceses in Northern Canada

which for many years had also been under the jurisdiction of the Congregation.



#### <u>Food for Your Journey – Counting Years</u> <u>Backwards</u>

Somewhere in South America there is an Indian tribe whose idea of the past and future seems to be exactly opposite to ours. We refer to the past as behind us, and to the future as ahead of us.

To this particular tribe however, the past is thought of as being ahead of them, and the future as being behind them.

At first, this may seem very strange to us, and many will undoubtedly wonder how anyone could possibly think that way.

The reasoning of these Indians is quite logical. It goes like this: All that they have experienced: their mistakes and failures and lessons learned and so on is considered as being in front of them. And it is there for their contemplation and betterment. The future, on the other hand, is behind them because it has not yet been experienced.

We have this same idea in Tok Pisin, where we refer to the future as *taim bihain*, that is, the time that is coming somewhat later.

The only negative expression in the lot, is to say that someone's future is behind him!
