Viewing may lead to confusion, anxiety and depression, a porn addiction, unrealistic or unhealthy expectations, or to on-line sexual exploitation. What can we do? Join the campaign to urge the government to stop easy access to pornography by mandating that adult websites install meaningful age verification systems.
