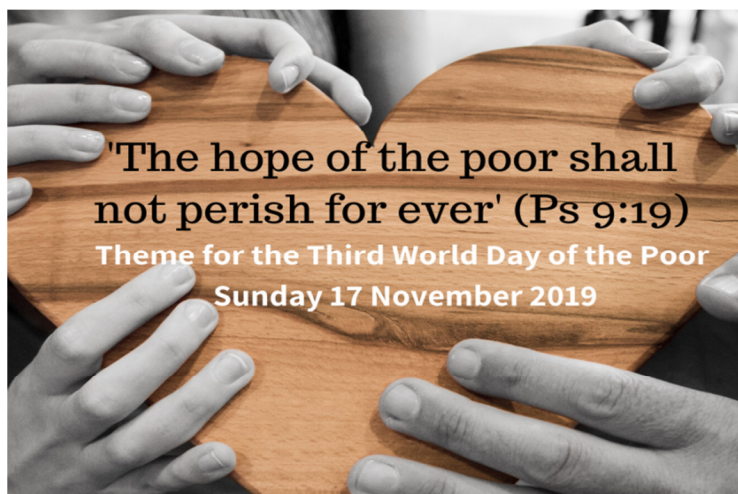


### CWL Christmas Tea & Bazaar
