Words from the Pastor

Praise be to JESUS CHRIST.

Finally we are stepping in to summer. The migrants' birds started coming back, grass began to turn green and trees started sprouting. At the fall the trees shed it's leaves with a hope that they will get it back in spring. Though the snow covers the grass knew that one day, when the sun rises, the snow will melt away and they will get their green blanket back. The migrant birds fly in with a new hope for a better life, though it is not secured. It is a lesson of hope that we learn from the nature.

The Covid 19 Pandemic too taught us a lesson. Many of the things that we thought 'is a must' in our life we realize they were not. We did survive without them. It didn't cause any damage to our lives. May it be our shopping, staying indoors, travels, visits, etc. When we look back we realize that a lions part of things we did in our life were of no use or little use. I believe it's a time to introspect into our lives, how do we live it?
