**From the Pastor's Desk**

Praise be to Jesus Christ.

We often hear people complain about things that they don't have. Very seldom we see them being happy and satisfied with what they have. As someone said, "I mourned and complained once, because I had no shoes...then I met a man who had no feet...and I bowed my head with shame for my complaints."

In the Gospel of Matthew (14.13-21) we see the 'multiplications of bread'. Jesus' response to the words of Disciples, to send people away to let them eat something before it gets dark was, "you give them something to eat." But the Disciples had only five loaves of bread and two fish to offer the huge crowd. Amazingly when they gave it to Jesus it was sufficient to feed a large crowd and they could collect twelve baskets full of what was left over. This miracle teaches us something new. When you offer what you have to God, He multiplies it.

The question for our meditation is: Are you ready to offer what you have to God? It may be your skills, abilities, wealth, or even a broken heart. When you offer it to God, God works miracles. As it is said, 'The God who created you without your consent cannot save you without it.'

May God bless you and protect you from all the possible dangers.
