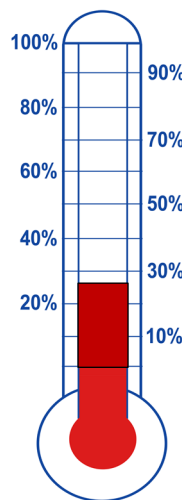

Statue of St. Joseph

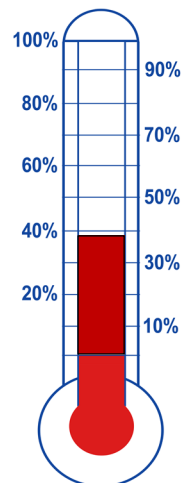
The Statue of St. Joseph will be installed near the door of the crying room.
