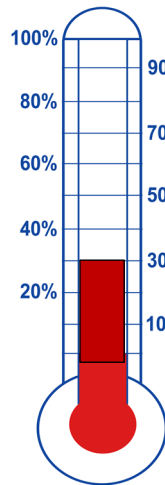

Two boxes were donated to the Friendship Center and all the rest to Salvation Army. Well done! And now, you are asked to do more and continue to “Stretch forth your hand to the poor” by reaching out to the Family Centre which is now open 24/7 to provide shelter and food for the homeless. Volunteers are presently feeding about 20 people and need help. Baking is appreciated as well as non-perishable items but what is needed more is cooked food ready to go. Slow cookers are available for heating but cooking on site is not an option. If you would like to provide a meal, call 274-9555 to arrange a day. Micaela (274-2273) loves to cook so if you would prefer, donate some food items to her and she will do the cooking! Let's see if our parish can get on board and help by feeding the hungry. The reason we have gifts is so that we can be gifts." **Note:** The Family Centre will reduce its hours to 8am to 8pm once the warming centre opens.

Statue of St. Joseph

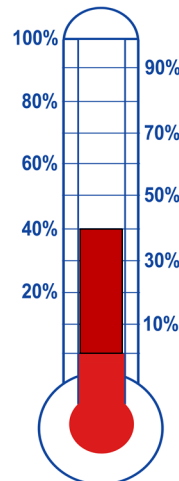
The Statue of St. Joseph will be installed near the door of the crying room.
