On January 31, 2021, Pope Francis announced a new celebration in honour of all grandparents and the elderly, who are so important to our communities and our Church. This new World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated every year on the fourth Sunday in July.

Pope Francis has also granted a plenary indulgence to grandparents, the elderly, and all those who participate in a solemn celebration of this day as well as to those who spend time (actually or virtually) with an elderly brother or sister in need on this day.

Being an elderly person himself, Pope Frances feels with the grandparents and he encourages all of them, "the whole Church is close to you – to us – and cares about you, loves you and does not want to leave you alone!"

The Pope understands the pain we all go through in this unending and exhaustic pandemic. The isolations and loneliness should never put us down as we are to feel the assuring presence of Jesus Christ in all times, "I am with you always" (Mt 28:20).

Jesus' presence can be felt through the angels like the grandkids, friends and families. The elders are requested to impart the gift of faith to the people around. The Pope urges all the grandparents and elders to start something new everyday as he says, "because there is no retirement age from the work of proclaiming the Gospel and handing down traditions to your grandchildren. 
