Feast of The Holy Cross

September 14 is the feast of the Holy Cross. The Exaltation of the Holy Cross celebrates two historical events: the discovery of the True Cross by Saint Helena, the mother of the Emperor Constantine, in 320 under the temple of Venus in Jerusalem, and the dedication in 335 of the basilica and shrine built on Calvary by Constantine, which mark the site of the Crucifixion.

More than the historical facts, this feast is a commemoration of God's greatest work: Christ's salvific death on the Cross and His Resurrection, through which death was defeated and the doors to Heaven opened.

Saint Paul elucidates this Christology to the Colossians, "For in Christ all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him God was pleased to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, by making peace through the blood of his cross".(Col 1:19-20)

We praise and worship our Lord and God for healing us through the Holy Cross. We pray that God mercifully grants us the grace and courage to take up our cross and follow him.
