### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### St. Teresa of Ávila Spiritual Reading Room

St. Teresa of Ávila, also called Saint Teresa of Jesus, Spanish nun, was one of the great mystics and religious women of the Roman Catholic Church, and author of spiritual classics. She was elevated to doctor of the church in 1970 by Pope Paul VI, the first woman to be so honoured.

To her, spiritual life was an attitude of love, not a rule. Although she proclaimed poverty, she believed in work, not in begging. She believed in obedience to God more than penance. **If you do something wrong, don't punish yourself -- change.** When someone felt depressed, her advice was that she go some place where she could see the sky and take a walk.

She wrote many masterpieces on the progress of the Christian soul toward God through prayer and contemplation. St. Teresa is the patron saint of Headache sufferers. Her symbol is a heart, an arrow, and a book.

We have named our spiritual reading room as "**St. Teresa of Ávila Spiritual Reading Room**" to honor the first ever woman doctor of the Church. This spiritual reading room will be blessed by our Bishop Colli on November 5, Friday evening at 6 pm.

You are welcome to come, read, reflect and pray in the spiritual reading room. I like to thank Gina Sigurdson and Maria Slusarchuk, who organised the books and helped the place look like a reading room. Come and spiritually nourish yourself.

#### Covid-19 Update:

With the Province of Ontario lifting some capacity limits to certain establishments this week, this change does not affect our parish churches. We still remain at our capacity limits, depending on social distancing. To move to full capacity with no distancing would mean that only fully vaccinated people may attend Mass. We cannot move to that situation at this time. We encourage everyone to be vaccinated for their safety and the safety of their families and those around them. Masks are still required to be worn at Mass and hand sanitizing is recommended. There is still no congregational singing, and Communion is to be received in the hand. Social distancing must take place outside of the church also. Small meetings of up to 25 people may take place in parish halls, as long as everyone is fully vaccinated.
