FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Advent: A time of waiting and preparing

We are in the holy season of Advent, a time of waiting and preparing for the coming of Christ. It is an invitation to wait—quietly, patiently, expectantly, joyfully. Advent says, "Wait, slow down! Don't get entangled in the hustle and the bustle of the season. Get focused instead on what really matters."

Advent is a time of preparing our hearts to welcome Jesus anew by examining our hearts to see how distant we've grown from God, taking stock of how we have failed to live by God's priorities.

Many families have a tradition of praying around an Advent wreath and reflecting on each day's Scripture readings. The progression of lighted candles on the wreath each week reminds us that we are called to be everbrighter lights in the world through our words and actions.

The color purple is used a lot — as part of the Advent wreath, the church's decorations and the priest's vestments at Mass. Purple is a penitential color (it's also used during Lent). We use it during Advent because penance is an important part of our preparation to welcome the coming of Christ.

If we use the time before Dec. 25 to prepare ourselves for Christ's coming with additional prayer, generous service and participating in the sacrament of reconciliation, we will feel the joy of Christmas even more strongly when it really does arrive.

May we all have a blessed and grace filled Advent season!
