Covid-19 Update

With the Province of Ontario lifting some capacity limits to certain establishments this week, this change does not affect our parish churches. We still remain at our capacity limits. depending on social distancing. To move to full capacity with no distancing would mean that only fully vaccinated people may attend Mass. We cannot move to that situation at this time. We encourage everyone to be vaccinated for their safety and the safety of their families and those around them. Masks are still required to be worn at Mass and hand sanitizing is recommended. There is still no congregational singing, and Communion is to be received in the hand. Social distancing must take place outside of the church also. Small meetings of up to 25 people may take place in parish halls, as long as everyone is fully vaccinated. We ask you to continue to follow these safety norms as we move slowly out of this pandemic time. Thank you.

What is a Synod?

"Synod" is an ancient and venerable word in the Tradition of the Church which indicates the path along which the people of God walk together. The word "synod", has its roots in two Greek words: syn meaning "together" and hodos meaning "road" or "way".

The purpose of *the Synod on Synodality* is to discuss the fundamental questions:

*How is this journeying together happening today in your particular Church?

*What steps does the Holy Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our journeying together?

The purpose of the Synod, and therefore of this consultation, is not to produce documents, and in the Holy Father's own words, it is: "a time to plant dreams, draw forth prophecies and visions, allow hope to flourish, inspire trust, bind up wounds, weave together relationships, awaken a dawn of hope, learn from one another and create a bright resourcefulness that will enlighten minds, warm hearts, give strength to our hands"

Who can participate?


All who are baptised as Catholics, whether priests, deacons, religious or lay people, both individually and in associations, should participate at the diocesan level.


