The Story of Our Lady of Guadalupe

Our Lady of Guadalupe holds a special place in the religious life of Mexico and is one of the most popular religious devotions. Her feast day is December 12. The feast in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe goes back to the 16th century.

Juan Diego was a 57-year-old widower in a small village near Mexico City. On Saturday morning December 9, 1531 Juan was walking by a hill called Tepeyac when he heard beautiful music like the warbling of birds. A radiant cloud appeared, and within it stood a maiden dressed like a princess. The lady spoke to him in his own language and sent him to the bishop of Mexico, a Franciscan named Juan de Zumarraga. The bishop was to build a chapel in the place where the lady appeared.

Eventually the bishop told Juan to have the lady give him a sign. About this same time Juan's uncle became seriously ill. This led poor Juan to try to avoid the lady. Nevertheless, the lady found Juan, assured him that his uncle would recover, and provided roses for Juan to carry to the bishop in his cape or tilma.

On December 12, when Juan Diego opened his cloak in the bishop's presence, the roses fell to the ground, and the bishop sank to his knees. On the cloak where the roses had been appeared an image of Mary exactly as she had appeared at the hill of Tepeyac. Pope John Paul II canonized Juan Diego and declared Our Lady of Guadalupe the patroness of the Americas.

To the present day, Our Lady of Guadalupe remains a powerful symbol of Mexican identity and faith, and her image is associated with everything from motherhood to feminism to social justice.


Our Lady of Guadalupe had this to say to Juan Diego:

"Know for certain that I am the perfect and perpetual Virgin Mary, Mother of the True God through whom everything lives. It is my earnest wish that a temple be built here in my honor. Here I will hear their weeping, their sorrow, and will remedy and alleviate all their multiple sufferings, necessities and misfortunes."

Let us all intercede through our Lady of Guadalupe.
