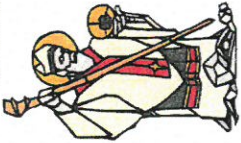
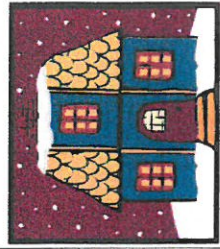

General Meeting Wednesday, March 1 at 6:30: there will be the wearing of the green in honour of St. Patrick! The rosary will be prayed prior to the meeting for those who wish to participate.

World Day of Prayer, Friday, March 3 at 2:00 Zion Lutheran Church 1105 Scott St.: this is an international ecumenical Christian laywomen's initiative. It is run under the motto "*Informed Prayer and Prayerful Action*," and is celebrated annually in over 170 countries. Its purpose is to encourage Christian women to engage in personal and communal prayer within their mission auxiliaries and associations. The prayer service is based on the theme "*I have heard about your faith*" written by the women of Taiwan. All the women of our parish are invited to attend.

St. Patrick's Day, Friday, March 17: to celebrate St. Patrick is to celebrate evangelization.
