



## March 19 - Solemnity of Saint Joseph (Moved to March 20 in 2023)

We celebrate two feast days for Joseph: primary and highest feast on **March 19 for Joseph the Husband of Mary** and May 1 for Joseph the Worker. After the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph is the greatest of the saints. He is the one "into whose custody God entrusted his most precious treasures," Jesus and Mary. Because this feast is a solemnity, even though it falls during Lent, the faithful are dispensed of their Lenten obligations on this day.

Mary and Joseph, the greatest saints of all time, lived an ordinary, hidden life, and that sanctity consisted in daily expressions of love in family life, work, and prayer. Where it is celebrated, the feast can be a time for couples to renew their marriage vows to one another.
