Chrism Mass

The Chrism Mass is where the bishop will consecrate the sacred oils used in the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick, and Holy Orders. Each parish receives these oils at the Chrism Mass. There are three oils that are consecrated: The Oil of Catechumens. The Oil of the Infirm and The Holy Chrism.

The blessing of the Holy Chrism is different from that of the other two. Symbolizing the Holy Spirit descending, the bishop breathes over the vessel of chrism. At this time, the con-celebrants at the Chrism Mass extend their right hands toward the chrism as the bishop says the Consecration Prayer.

Chrism Mass is also the time of the annual renewal of priestly promises. With all the priests of the diocese present before the bishop, they renew their fidelity to Jesus Christ and the local Bishop.

Traditionally Chrism Mass was celebrated on Holy Thursday, though for pastoral reasons it is celebrated on a different day during Lent. (2023 March 30, Thursday, 5 pm @ St. Patrick's Cathedral, Thunder Bay.)

Let us also pray for our bishop and the priests who are the ministers of the sacraments in the parish, that they may be the humble and generous servants of the Lord.
