Pentecost, which this year is 16 June.

It all started when St. Margaret Mary **Alacogue** received private revelations from Jesus Christ. Jesus spoke to her on June 16, 1675, and asked her specifically to promote a feast that honored his Sacred Heart.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus offers us comfort and refuge, particularly in times of trial and distress. We turn to the Sacred Heart in prayer, seeking solace, guidance, and healing. It is seen as a powerful symbol of hope, offering reassurance that Jesus understands our struggles and remains present in our lives.


The devotion to the Sacred Heart calls for acts of compassion, forgiveness, and selfless love towards one's neighbors, reflecting the transformative power of Christ's love within the world. The Sacred Heart devotion inspires us to remember how much Jesus loves us, while also growing our desire to love Him back.



At St. Mary's we will have a novena to the Sacred Heart after the daily morning Mass for nine days, starting on Saturday, June 10th. We will have the feast celebrated on Sunday, June 18th at the 11 am Mass.




