Saint Teresa of Ávila was a Spanish Carmelite nun, mystic, who lived in the 16th century. Saint Teresa is renowned for her mystical experiences which included visions, raptures, and a deep sense of union with the Divine.

The 3 Lessons we learn from the life of St. Teresa of Avila are: i) First prayer, then action. ii) Surround yourself with good friends and mentors. iii) Take life, and yourself, lightly.

Teresa of Avila is the patron saint of those who suffer from headaches and migraines. those who are ill, people ridiculed for their religious faith, and Spain. Saint Teresa of Ávila died on October 4, 1582, and her feast day is celebrated on October 15th.

Powerful Prayer of Saint Teresa of Ávila Guided by You Lord, grant that I may always allow myself to be guided by You, always follow Your plans. May Your Will be done in time and in eternity by me, in me, And through me. Amen.


CWL 50/50 tickets are now available! This is a major fundraising activity for the CWL. Anyone wanting to assist us in selling them, books are available at the parish office or by
