From the Pastor's Desk

Saul to Saint Paul (January 25)
"you encounter Jesus, you change your life"


The conversion of Saint Paul, one of the great events of the early Church, is celebrated as a powerful example of divine intervention.

Saul, who was on his way to Damascus to persecute Christians, experienced a dramatic encounter. A bright light from heaven blinded him, and he heard a voice saying, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" Saul asked who was speaking, and the voice identified itself as Jesus, whom Saul was persecuting. This encounter led to Saul's conversion to Christianity.

After his conversion, Saul changed his name to Paul. He embarked on missionary journeys, wrote several letters (Epistles). Of the 27 books in the New Testament, 13 are attributed to Paul. Today, Paul's epistles continue to be the roots of theology, worship and pastoral life.

Paul's conversion symbolizes that even those vehemently opposed to Christianity can experience a profound change of heart and purpose through a direct encounter with the divine. **This feast is celebrated on January 25**. Praise the Lord!




