From the Pastor's Desk

How Not to Pray

During the Lenten season, we tend to spend more time in prayer. Here are some suggestions on how not to pray and how to pray.

Prayer is not just repeating words by rote. Avoid simply reciting prayers without sincere thought or feeling. Prayer has no place for selfishness. Avoid approaching prayer solely with self-centered requests or demands. Prayer is not a time for letting your mind wander or focusing on unrelated tasks. Avoid distractions or multitasking while praying.

Prayer is not a magic formula for getting what you want immediately. Prayer is not a quickfix. Prayer time is not to experience doubts or negative emotions. Prayer does not confine to a specific formula or set of prayers if they don't resonate with you.

Ultimately, the key to meaningful prayer lies in sincerity, authenticity, and a genuine desire to connect with our God who is all forgiving, compassionate and merciful. Let us use our prayer time to ask for guidance and strength to help us overcome challenges, grow in faith, and live out the values of the Lenten season.

Prayer is an opportunity to examine our conscience, seek forgiveness for any wrongdoing, and reconcile with others. Remember that Lent is a time of spiritual renewal and growth, so we may approach our prayer with openness, humility, and a willingness to be transformed by the grace of God.
