From the Pastor's Desk Saint Joseph's Day (March 19)

The greatness of Saint Joseph is that he placed himself, in the words of Saint John Chrysostom, 'at the service of the entire plan of salvation'.

God told Joseph: 'Son of David, do not be afraid!' (Mt 1:20). God seems to tell us: 'Do not be afraid!' When things do not turn out as we wish, we need to set aside all anger and disappointment, and to embrace the way they are. Not with mere resignation but with hope and courage.

In this way, we are open to a deeper meaning. Our lives miraculously change if we have the courage to live them in line with the Gospel. It does not matter if everything seems to have gone wrong. God can make flowers spring up from stony ground. Even if our heart condemns us, 'God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything'(1 Jn 3:20).

Each of us can discover in Joseph – the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence – an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble. Saint Joseph reminds us that those who appear hidden or in the shadows can play an incomparable role in the history of salvation.

May the intercession of Saint Joseph protect and provide for our families. May I wish you all a Happy feast!
