

### From the Pastor's Desk


#### **Doubting Thomas**

This Sunday's Gospel talks about Saint Thomas the Apostle, also known as "Doubting Thomas". Following Jesus's resurrection, Thomas was not present when Jesus appeared to the other disciples. When they told him they had seen the risen Jesus, Thomas expressed doubt, stating that he would not believe unless he saw Jesus with his own eyes and touched His wounds.

About a week later, Jesus appeared to the disciples again, including Thomas. Jesus invited Thomas to touch His wounds and urged him not to doubt but to believe. In response, Thomas exclaimed, "My Lord and my God!" expressing his newfound faith. His encounter with the risen Christ leads to a heartfelt declaration of faith, making him an example of renewal and belief.

The story of "Doubting Thomas" encourages believers to battle with their doubts honestly while remaining open to encountering the truth of Christ. Doubt can be at times a stepping stone to a more mature and authentic faith. Saint Thomas is often invoked as the patron saint of those struggling with doubt. We pray for brethren who doubt and who have lost faith, that they may believe, that they may be enlightened by the risen Christ.


