The month of September is dedicated to *Our Lady of Sorrows*, whose memorial the Church celebrates on September 15. Our Sorrowful Mother helps us to reflect on the suffering Mary experienced. The feast day of the Most Holy Name of the Blessed Virgin Mary is celebrated on September 12. Among her titles are *Holy Mary, Immaculate Mary, Our Lady of Good Counsel, Our Lady of the Rosary, Mary Queen of the Saints ... Mother Mary ... Jesus*, who gave us the eminent gift of his Mother even as he was dying on the cross: *"Then he said to the disciple, 'Here is your mother'"* (John 19:27). In difficult times, we can pray,

"Mary, Mother of Jesus, be Mother to me now."

Prayer of St. Francis of Assisi (Prayer for Peace)

Lord, make me an instrument of your peace: where there is hatred, let me sow love; where there is injury, pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy.

O divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved as to love.

For it is in giving that we receive, it is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life.
