



Bishop Campeau believes 'we can raise the profile of the faith communities across the diocese by keeping our minds set on the thing that are above. The Spirit is alive, and we know that we are doing what God wants of us. Together we can build a vibrant and life-giving Church.'

The Bishop has revamped & reduced the overall total for the campaign to \$400,000 from \$435,000.

The goal for St. Mary's is \$20,950.00.

The goal for Our Lady of Lourdes is \$4,800.00.

The campaign runs until December 31, 2025.




