

Peace Takes Everyone

The Holy Father has chosen the theme '*Good politics is at the service of peace*'.

The World Day of Peace was established by Pope Paul VI in 1968 who

asked that "every year, this commemoration be repeated as a hope and as a promise, at the beginning of the calendar which measures and outlines the path of human life in time, that Peace with its just and beneficent equilibrium may dominate the development of events to come."

Food for Your Journey - Desiring Happiness for Others

David Garroway was one of the first TV talk-show personalities. After he had become quite wealthy, he was asked one day about his sense of Christmas. He said he had noticed that the older one gets, the harder it is to tell people what you want for Christmas.

"I've noticed," he said, "that most people ask for something material for Christmas. This used to amuse me, but it doesn't any more. I happen to be a person who can afford anything he wants. But I find that what I really want, I can't buy at all. I want peace - peace of mind - peace of soul. The kind of peace you have when you don't really want anything.

"Nowadays when I ask that question, I phrase it this way: 'What if you had everything you wanted... what if you had all the money in the world... what if you could buy anything you wanted... then what would you like to Christmas?'

"One little girl stopped me with her answer. She said, 'I'd like happiness,' and then added, 'for others.'

"How Christmassy that is! It's like the little girl who prayed at the end of the day: 'God, I had a great time today,' and then she added, 'I hope you had a good time, too.'"
