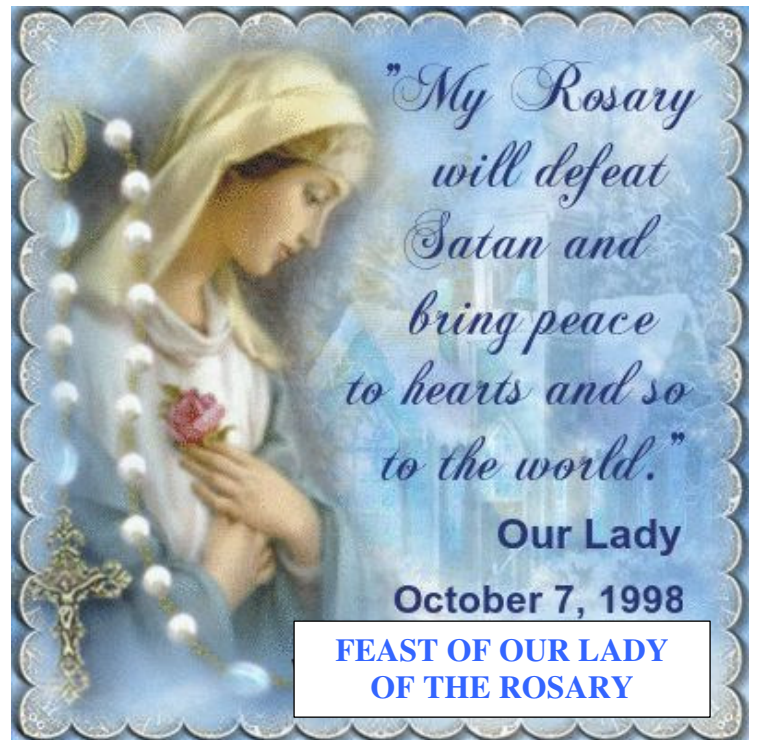


Please remember that on you cannot park in front or on the avenue in the spots marked off for the Covid-19 Assessment Centre across the street from
