Upcoming Events

General Meeting, Wednesday, March 4, 6:30: it's the *"Wearing of the Green"* in honour of St. Patrick and the importance of evangelization. So put on some green and join in prayer and fellowship. **Note:** the rosary for world peace will be prayed prior to the meeting at 6:00 for those who wish to participate.

Feast Day of St. Patrick, Tuesday, March the 17: although not Irish by birth, St. Patrick is known for his evangelization by bringing Christianity to the Irish and, as well, tried to establish good and honest governance and worked to abolish slavery and improve social justice. The collect for St Patrick's Day, reads, *"O God, who chose the Bishop Saint Patrick to preach your glory to the peoples of Ireland, grant, through his merits and intercession, that those who glory in the name of Christian may never cease to proclaim your wondrous deeds to all."*

Feast of the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Thursday, March 19: St. Joseph is honoured as the spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary and earthly father of Jesus Christ - for his faithfulness and obedience to God's will, choosing to be the protector and provider of the Holy Family. St. Pope John Paul II said, *"Because St. Joseph is the protector of the Church, he is the guardian of the Eucharist and the Christian family."*

Solemnity of the Annunciation on Wednesday, March 25: The Annunciation is the angel Gabriel's announcement to Mary that she would bear the Son of God, Jesus Christ. It also marks her acceptance as she placed herself completely at the service of God's will. This was the beginning of the Incarnation when Jesus took on His human nature. Whenever we need courage in saying "yes" to God, we can look to Mary as the best example. We pray, *"Hail, Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you!"*
